



**HOW TO TRACK A STORM**

1. Note the latest storm position and strength as reported by the National Hurricane Center.
2. Find the latitude (horizontal lines) and longitude (vertical lines) on the map. Mark the coordinates with the date and time given in the report.
3. As updates are announced, mark the new coordinates appropriately.
